## % PERCENTAGE

- 20... : twenty, twenty-one, twenty-two, twenty-three...
- 30, 40, ... 90 : thirty, forty, fifty, sixty, seventy, eighty, ninety
- 100 ... : one hundred/a hundred, two hundred, three hundred...
- 101... : a hundred and one, a hundred and two...
- 200... : two hundred, three hundred, four hundred...
- 1,000 ... : one thousand / a thousand, two thousand...
- 1,001 : one thousand and one
- 1,000,000 ... : one million / a million, two million, three million...
- 1,000,000,000 ... : one billion / a billion, two billion, three billion...
